JMU was abstracted/indexed by EMBASE, SIIC Databases (Sociedad Iberoamericana de Informacion Cientifica), Science Direct, Scopus, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) and Emerging Sources Citation Index (ESCI). JMU also passed the Scientific Quality Review by NLM for PubMed Central (PMC) in April 2017. The new publisher will take over the application procedure for the next review of SCI.

Dr. WJ Lee (KSUMB) particularly appreciated SUM/CMA for their great support. China submitted nearly 200 abstracts, which was much higher than the 116 abstracts submitted from the hosting country Korea.

Agenda 13. AFSUMB 2020 Progress Report by Dr. Qingli Zhu on behalf of Dr. Yu-Xin Jiang [\[Attachment 10, p30-36 in the attached file\]](#).

The 14th congress of AFSUMB will be held in the Beijing International Convention Center at Beijing from Aug. 28 to 30, 2020. After the presentation by Dr. Zhu, several councilors suggested that more speakers should be invited from Asia to highlight the congress of “Asian” AFSUMB, and suggested that the 3 days’ congress be extended to 4 days.

Agenda 14. AFSUMB Education Workshop: Report by Dr. Kwok Yin Leung.

These are the countries that have hosted the workshop (WS) in the last 7years: 2010 Mongolia, 2011 Indonesia, 2012 Hong Kong, 2013 Singapore, 2014 Nepal, 2015 Taiwan, 2016 Thailand, 2017 China. The AFSUMB Education WS in 2018 will be hosted by India in November, 2018. The AFSUMB Education WS in 2019 will be hosted by Indonesia, where the AFSUMB AC meeting of 2019 will also be taken place there. Dr. Praveen (IFSUMB) was worried because there is only a deposit of around USD 5,000 in the AFSUMB Education bank account, which is less than 10,000 required for WS. However, it was decided that this issue is to be solved by the new officers of AFSUMB.

Agenda 15. Call for a proposal from the affiliated societies to host the Congress of AFSUMB 2022(According to AFSUMB BY-LAWS # 25). The deadline of the proposal was determined for the end of September 2018. The proposal should include tentative dates, proposed venues, tentative costs, registration fees, tentative programs or agendas, strengths of the organizing committee, convenience of transportation, special events, climate, support, and resources for the meeting, the division of meeting surplus revenue between host-organization(s) and the Federation, special advantages of the sites, and any other appropriate information which would be beneficial to the attendees.

Agenda 16.Place and date for the next AC meeting. It was decided that the 2019 workshop would be held in Indonesia. Indonesia showed interest in hosting the AFSUMB Education Workshop and AFSUMB Council Meeting. According to the SOP for financial supports for AFSUMB activities, in this condition, the arrangement should be as follows:

- (a) AFSUMB: shall support USD 5,000 to the hosting society and airfare (economic class) for AFSUMB Council Members.

(b) Hosting society: should pay all other expenses including accommodations, local transportation and meals for AFSUMB Council Members.

Agenda 17. New or other business.

Dr. WJ Lee (KSUM) emphasized that he will try to get more resources from the industries for AFSUMB.

Agenda 18. Presentation of Gold Medals to past Presidents.

During the AFSUMB AC or GA meeting at Kyoto in May 2016, the AFSUMB did not prepare a Gold Medal and gift for the past president of AFSUMB Dr. Seung Hyup Kim. Thus, this time, on behalf of AFSUMB, Dr. Yi-Hong Chou presented a Gold Medal and a gift to Dr. Seung Hyup Kim for his great contribution to the Federation during his tenure as President of AFSUMB (2012-2014). Similarly, the current president of AFSUMB, Dr. Masatoshi Kudo presented a Gold Medal and a gift to the immediate past president of AFSUMB, Dr. Yi-Hong Chou, for his substantial contribution to AFSUMB during his tenure as President of AFSUMB (2014-2016).


















Agenda 1. Inauguration remark and greetings from the president, Dr. Kudo.

Before the remark by the President, a plaque of AFSUMB President was awarded to Dr. Masatoshi Kudo.

Based on the treasurer's report by Dr. Iwaki on 20171014 during the AFSUMB AC meeting (the amount is shown in USD), the actual revenue was \$ 277,131.28, and the expense was \$ 47,313.00. Current balance of AFSUMB account is \$229,818.28. The current balance of Donation account from Samsung is -\$4486.39 (minus), because Samsung has not paid the donation yet.

Agenda 8. Journal Editor's Report

Editor, Dr. San-Kan LEE reported:

The Journal of Medical Ultrasound (JMU) has published 6 issues since May 2016 when AFSUMB Congress was held at Kyoto Japan. There were 19 original articles and 6 review articles submitted from Bangladesh (2), Brazil (1), Canada (1), China (2), Egypt (3), India (1) Ireland (2), Italy (1), Japan (3), Singapore (1), South Africa (1), Spain (1), USA (3) and Taiwan (3). More manuscripts are under review, but the journal is still shortage of manuscripts of articles. The editorial board of JMU is urgently and sincerely looking forward to submission of more original articles and case reports from the members of AFSUMB.

Elsevier, the publisher of our journal, is going to withdraw their business from Taiwan next year (2018). Thus, the issuing affairs of JMU will be transferred to another publisher – Wolters Kluwer Health/Medknow. The Editorial board is dealing with the contract now, and the publication is under the process. It is a good news to know that since this year, JMU has been abstracted/indexed in EMBASE, SIIC Data Bases, ScienceDirect, Scopus, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) and Emerging Sources Citation Index (ESCI). JMU also has passed the Scientific Quality Review by NLM for Pubmed Central (PMC) this April.

The "Visiting Scholarship" program of the CTSUM is as usual: the winners will be invited to attend the Annual Congress of the CTSUM and deliver a speech about their articles in JMU. The CTSUM offers the winner \$2,000 USD to support the air fare, accommodation and personal expenses for his/her stay in Taiwan. The winner of 2017 is Dr. Niranjan Sahu, the topic of the paper is "Role of abdominal ultrasound in the diagnosis of typhoid fever in pediatric patients" (J Med Ultrasound 24(4) : 150-153, Dec. 2016). The author will be invited to attend the Annual Congress of CTSUM 2018 and share his study at a special session.

Question:

There is “E-learning (video): ASAUT 2015 TPE” at the section of Education. AFSUMB has to pay \$160.00 every 3 months to maintain the video system. The due of the present agreement is November 27th, 2017. Does the AFSUMB plan to continue the contract? The name of company is Logic-Design. The video system has a limitation of 10 GB, AFSUMB had been using 9 GB. The number of access was 238 from 2016/4/1 to 2016/12/31 and 240 from 2017/1/1 to 2017/10/23. A total amount of USD 840.00 (640+30+170) had been paid to Dr. Satoshi Nakatani by Treasurer Dr. Iwaki. The amount included USD 640 for e-learning contents for 1 year, USD 30 for internet maintenance fee and 17 times uploading fee USD 170 this year. After discussion with AC members as well as the President Elect Dr. Won Jae Lee, it was determined to continue the contract for at least 3 months.

Agenda 10. Committee Chairs' Report

1) Education committee (Chair of education committee, Dr. Kwok Yin LEUNG)

AFSUMB work shop was held at Bangkok Thailand in Sep. 2016 and at Beijing China in August 2017. Probably India, Philippine and Indonesia will be the potential organizers of the future education workshop.

2) History and Archive committee

Chair of history and archive committee, Dr. Musarrat HASAN,

In the last meeting held at Kyoto Japan in May 2016, it was suggested by the council members that most of the material related to archiving can be placed in CD or in the web site, instead of printing heavy booklets, which would increase the cost. Hence we are in the process of releasing smaller booklets with supportive CDs. Dr. Hasan presented to the council the sample in the council meeting. He requested all members to send him more material so that it can be incorporated within one year, which would be probably be during the AFSUMB council meeting at Seoul Korea in 2018. He appreciated all the executive members for their suggestions and support.

3) *Ultrasound Contrast Agent committee*

Dr. Jae Young Lee (KSUM) is the Chair. The committee members include Dr. Masatoshi Kudo (Japan), Yi-Hong Chou (Taiwan) and Min-Hua Chen (China).

4) *Ultrasound Safety committee*: Dr. Iwaki Akiyama [[Attachment 3](#)]

Members: Dr. Pai-chi Li and Dr. Dong-Guk Paeng

The Committee agreed to upload the safety recommendation regarding the Shear Wave Elastography based on the studies (References 1-4 in attachment).

This recommendation has not yet been discussed by the each society.

Safety of acoustic radiation force impulse

Since there has been no medical consensus concerning the safety of the use of acoustic radiation force impulse (ARFI, called as push pulse) for biological tissues, especially for the fetus, fetuses should not be exposed to acoustic radiation force impulse (push pulse). In the case of the Shear Wave Elastography with ARFI (push pulse) used for the uterine during the pregnancy, even if the fetus is estimated as excluded from ROI, the risk of fetus exposure to ARFI cannot be neglected from various points of view (see the references in the attached file).

5) *Constitution Committee*: The Chair of the 13th Constitution Committee is Dr. Kanu Bala (BSU). The member included Dr. M Kudo, Dr. YH Chou, Dr. WJ Lee, Dr. YL Wan. The last constitution was revised on November 20, 2010, and was effective from November 20, 2010. The Meeting of the Constitution Committee of the AFSUMB was held at 9.00 am to 10.00 am on 14 October 2017, Saturday at TICC, Room No 401, Taipei, Taiwan. The following topics were discussed in the meeting:

- (a) The proposals for amendment to the AFSUMB Constitution will be proposed and done during the AFSUMB Congress 2018 in Seoul, Korea.
- (b) Proposals will be invited from the member organizations.
- (c) Congress levy of 25% on surplus amount will be charged from the host organization.
- (d) Industry donations, subject to the rules of AFSUMB, can be taken. This point will be

clearly written.

- (e) An application form for new affiliation shall be drafted and added to the constitution as appendix..
- (f) The time sequence of the constitution should be corrected.
- (g) The amendment process will be completed in Seoul, Korea in 2018.

Agenda 13. Future AFSUMB's Education Workshops

Dr. Leung reported that four countries, namely, India, Nepal, Indonesia and Philippines showed their interest to host the AFSUMB workshop 2018. Both India and Philippines hosted the workshop in 2008, while the workshop was held in Indonesia in 2011 and Nepal in 2014. There were other considerations for Philippines. It was agreed to give the first priority to India Society given their need, and the second priority to Indonesia.

Countries that hosted the workshop in the last 7 years is shown as follow:

2010 Mongolia, 2011 Indonesia, 2012 Hong Kong, 2013 Singapore, 2014 Nepal, 2015 Taiwan, 2016 Thailand, China 2017.

It was finally decided that AFSUMB WS in 2018 will be hosted by India in November. .

Agenda 14. WFUMB 2017 Progress Report (CTSUM) Report

On behalf of the WFUMB Congress President Dr. Cheng-Won Chiang, Dr. Yung-Liang Wan reported the updated status of the 16th Congress of the World Federation for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology which was held at TICC, Taipei, Taiwan from Oct. 13 to 17, 2017.

Chinese Taipei Society of Ultrasound in Medicine organized the congress on behalf of AFSUMB. The congress was joined together with the 9th Asian Conference on Ultrasound Contrast Imaging (ACUCI) and Global Chinese Ultrasound Forum. World leaders in the field of medical ultrasonography delivered lectures on the latest development in ultrasound. In summary, there were 2,452 attendees (including 704 international participants) from 46 countries, and 406 invited speakers from 35 countries in WFUMB 2017 Taipei. Nearly 1,000 abstracts were accepted for poster or oral presentations.

Agenda 15. Nomination committee Report

According to the previous regulation, Dr. Kudo recommended the current President-elect, Professor Won Jae Lee (KSUM), to be the chair of the Nomination Committee, and the members should include the current secretary Dr. Yung-Liang Wan and treasurer Dr. Iwaki Akiyama.

Agenda 16. Place and date for the next council meeting

The next council meeting will take place during AFSUMB 2018, which will be held at COEX Mall, Gangnam gu, Seoul, South Korea from May 23 (Wed.) to 26 (Sat.), 2018.

Agenda 17. Hosting Congress of AFSUMB 2020

Three countries, including China, India and Singapore submitted proposals for hosting the 14th Congress of AFSUMB 2020 before the deadline November 30, 2016. The proposals included tentative dates, proposed venue, tentative costs, registration fees, tentative programs or agendas, strength of the organizing committee, convenience of transportation, special events, climate, support and resources for the meeting, special advantages of the sites, and any other appropriate information which would be beneficial to the attendees. Thailand also expressed interest in organizing the meeting, but only after the deadline.

In the last 13 years, the following countries hosted the Congress of AFSUMB: Japan (Utsunomiya) in 2004, Thailand (Bangkok) in 2007, India (New Delhi) in 2010, Indonesia (Bali) in 2012, Malaysia (Kuala Lumpur) in 2014 and Japan (Kyoto) in 2016. Singapore proposed joint bid by Medical Ultrasound Society Singapore (MUSS) and Singapore Radiological Society (SRS).

During the meeting, the secretary Dr. YL Wan emphasized that some of the officers of AFSUMB had been discussing about the resources of AFSUMB. To our knowledge, it is found that in the event of a congress meeting generating a surplus, the local organizer has to donate variable amount of surplus to the mother organization, e.g. 20% in AOSR, 50% in Asian Society of Cardiovascular Imaging (ASCI), and 30% in WFUMB (according to constitution and By-Law). Some of the organizers that hosted the Congress of AFSUMB in the past did donate part of the surplus to AFSUMB. Taiwan or CTSUM paid USD 50,000 to WFUMB for having the right of hosting WFUMB 2017 at Taipei. After the bidding presentation by three countries and thorough discussion, China won the right for hosting AFSUMB Congress in 2020 decided by voting members which was announced by the President Dr. Masatoshi Kudo. China generously promised to donate 50% of surplus to the AFSUMB.

Agenda 18. Application of Vietnam Society of Ultrasound in Medicine (VSUM) to join AFSUMB

Prof. Lee went to Vietnam early this year, where the delegates of Vietnam showed enthusiasm in joining AFSUMB. Prof. Chou opinioned that, in general, every Asian country is welcome to join AFSUMB. Their representative would be invited to be an observer, usually for two years so as to be familiar with the AFSUMB activities and responsibilities including payment of annual subscriptions. At present, there is no rigid system to define the exact number of paid members. It was agreed to invite Vietnam Society to submit a formal application to join. A reference of application form was provided by Prof. YH Chou and revised by Dr. Yung-Liang Wan and Dr. Kanu Bala. Dr. WJ Lee for further liaison with Vietnam Society. Prof. Bala suggested to add the endorsed application form as an appendix in the Constitution. Two nominees would be required, and Dr. WJ Lee could be one of them. A recognition letter from the Government would be required. Whether the ultrasound society was the sole representative from Vietnam, and objections from their own country, if any, would be clarified. In the meeting, delegates from Vietnam showed their enthusiasm to become the affiliated society of AFSUMB. According to BY-LAW of AFSUMB, Vietnam is welcome to be the observer of AFSUMB for two years.

Agenda 19. New business.

1. Dr. Kudo mentioned that nowadays, contrast-enhanced endoscopic US has been becoming more and more important especially for the diagnosis of lesions or cancers in the pancreas, bile duct, lymphadenopathy at perigastric area and submucosal tumor of stomach. If possible, he proposed to have workshops or panel sessions during the congress of AFSUMB 2018, and plans to published an AFSUMB guideline on contrast-enhanced endoscopic US after the congress. It was suggested to have around 6 speakers for the program of 2 to 3 hours. The program will be planned and arranged by Dr. Jae-Young Lee who is currently the Chair of Contrast Agent Committee of AFSUMB.
2. AFSUMB officers and treasurer change every two years. It has been inconvenient for many affiliated societies to remit the annual subscription fee to the bank accounts which changes every two years. It was discussed if it is possible to fix the AFSUMB bank account in one of the following three countries, including Japan, South Korea and Taiwan. The proposal will be discussed among the three countries and will have a final decision in the next AFSUMB AC meeting at Seoul in May 2018.

Agenda 20. Closing Remark from the President

Dr. Kudo appreciated all AC members for their attendance and active discussion in this meeting which was fruitful and productive. In this meeting, it was decided that AFSUMB work shop in 2018 will be held in India, AFSUMB congress in 2020 will be hosted by China, ultrasound society from Vietnam will become affiliated society of AFSUMB in two years,

and AFSUMB will establish a guideline for contrast-enhanced endoscopic US.

Report of Journal Editor on May 23 AC Meeting

The Elsevier has withdrawn their journal publishing market from Taiwan, therefore the Publisher of Journal of Medical Ultrasound (JMU) has been completely transferred from Elsevier to Wolters Kluwer Health/Medknow. The new website of our journal is www.jmuonline.org, and we have forwarded this information to Website/Newsletter editor Professor Nakatani on May 9 to change the JMU's hyperlink. JMU has been abstracted/indexed by EMBASE, SIIC Databases (Sociedad Iberoamericana de Informacion Cientifica), ScienceDirect, Scopus, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) and Emerging Sources Citation Index (ESCI). JMU also has passed the Scientific Quality Review by NLM for Pubmed Central (PMC) in April 2017. The new publisher will take over the application procedure for the next review of SCI.

For the item 6 of the minutes, because the budget of the workshop 2019 had not yet been confirmed, we did not send out an invitation to all societies for their proposals.

3. Progress of the AFSUMB Workshop in India 2018

The budget required for the coming workshop would be USD10,000, same as previous years, and including the airfares of all the AFSUMB speakers. This would be reported to AFSUMB AC.

Prof. YL Wan reported that the education funding was in negative balance previously. Prof. Kanu Bala mentioned the importance of continuation of the workshop every year. Prof. WJ Lee had discussed with the major ultrasound companies and explored the feasibility of increasing AFSUMB education funding. If more resources were available, AFSUMB would be able to support two or three workshops in the future. Dr. Hasan mentioned that some AFSUMB Council members, not from EC, might like to speak in an AFSUMB workshop and they could pay for their own travel expenses while the local organizer could support their accommodation charges.

4. AFSUMB Workshop 2019

As discussed in the item 2, an invitation was not sent to all societies for proposals of workshop 2019. This would be further discussed in the coming AC meeting.

Post-meeting notes: In the AFSUMB AC meeting held on May 23 at Seoul, it was decided that the 2019 workshop would be held in Indonesia, and Indonesia showed the interest in hosting the AFSUMB Education Workshop and AFSUMB Council Meeting. However, according to the AFSUMB regulation, in such a special condition, the arrangement is shown as follow:

- (a) AFSUMB: shall support USD 5,000 to the hosting society and airfare (economic class) for AFSUMB Council Members.
- (b) Hosting society: should pay all other expenses including accommodation, local transportation and meals for AFSUMB Council Members.

The Secretary of AFSUMB, Dr. Yung Liang Wan, had already notified the delegates of ISUMB Dr. H Sidharta.

5. AOB

There was no other business. The meeting was adjourned at 8:50am. A group photo was taken after the meeting.

(To take effect from January 1, 1993)

(Revised May 24, 2018, To take effect from May 24, 2018)

ARTICLE 1: NAME

The name of this organization shall be the Asian Federation of Societies for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology **(AFSUMB)**.

ARTICLE 4: AFFILIATION AND ASSOCIATION

Section 2

AFSUMB AFFILIATED WITH WORLD FEDERATION

AFSUMB shall be the affiliated organization of the World Federation for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology (WFUMB).

ARTICLE 6: THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Section 5

A General Assembly shall be convened at **every two years** at such times and places as prescribed by the Council which shall prepare the agenda of the meeting in accordance with the By-Laws. An Assembly may be called by the Administrative Council at other times on petition of the voting delegates from 20 per cent of the organizations represented.

ARTICLE 7: ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL

Section 2A

Each Affiliated Organization holding voting rights of at least 10% of the full Assembly membership (as computed on the basis of certified voting rights two calendar years before a Meeting of the General Assembly at which a new Administrative Council is to be elected, for example voting rights in year 2008 for election in year 2010) shall be entitled to nominate a councilor on the Administrative Council. Each such Affiliated Organization shall be so notified by the Secretary of the Federation, and shall inform the Secretary of the name of its nominee at least 6 3 months before the date of the General Assembly Meeting. A total number of Administrative Councilors shall be up to 6.

Section 2B

Each Affiliated Organization not qualified by Article 7 Section 2A shall have a right to nominate one or more candidates for vacancies as representatives on the Administrative Council of those organizations collectively. The Secretary will call for nominations which must be in the hands of the Federation's Secretary at least 3 months before the date of the General Assembly Meeting. The Secretary shall notify all those organizations of the names of all candidates not less than 12 6 months before the General Assembly meeting.

Section 3A

The Nominating Committee appointed by the President under Article 8 shall invite names from all Affiliated Organizations of candidates for the offices of President-Elect, Vice-President 1, Vice-President 2, Secretary and Treasurer one year 6 month before the date of the General Assembly Meeting. From the names submitted the Committee shall present to the Administrative Council at least 6 months 3 month before the date of the General Assembly Meeting, whichever is the later, one or more nominations for each of the above five offices.

Section 3B

The Administrative Council, after examination of nominations, may, at its discretion, make its own nominations for each office in addition to the nominations previously notified. The nominations must be communicated to all Affiliated Organizations at least 3 months one month before a Meeting of the General Assembly.

Section 3D

The Secretary shall prepare a ballot of all nominees for each office, designating the mode of nomination. The ballot shall be presented by the Council by air mail to the entire General Assembly membership at least 10 and not more than 50 days before a Meeting of the General Assembly.

ARTICLE 15: GIFTS AND GRANTS

The Federation shall be empowered to accept gifts, donations, grants and other funds within applicable laws. The Federation may accept donation from the industry, but should not endorse any particular brand of the industry.

25. SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCES

Section 4

Three Two years before the congress, the following actions shall be taken:

(a) The host organization shall report to the Administrative Council on its choice of site and provide an organization timetable, including firm reservation dates, budget outline including details of front money and cash flow plan (at current costs), anticipated revenue and surplus (if any). This shall include estimated attendance, proposed registration fee and exhibition charges, and shall also indicate currently available scales of hotel charges. The number of hotel rooms reserved, space estimated and facilities for the Meeting shall also be reported.

(b) At the same time the Administrative Council and host organization together shall formulate a scientific program policy. This shall cover: choice of particular topics to be emphasized, balance of contributed papers, invited reviews, posters, scientific exhibits, and arrangements for selecting/rejecting contributions.

Section 5

A joint Meeting of the Administrative Council Representatives and host organization shall, if possible, be held at a time before the congress, in order to agree to the detailed plans and figures.

Section 6

Publicity for the congress shall be coordinated with the host organization (including announcements and letterheads) and shall clearly indicate that it is under the auspices of the Federation. The host organization shall make use of the title "AFSUMB '92," "AFSUMB 1992," and the like, as well as the AFSUMB logo.

Section 7

Timely reports at regular intervals (and/or at the request for Administrative Council) shall be provided by the host organization to the Administrative Council on the progress of preparations for the meeting including financial status and problems encountered.

Section 8

The President of the Federation in the period immediately prior to the congress shall be "President or Co-President of the Congress."

Section 9

Attendance at the congress and active participation in its scientific sessions shall be open to anyone with a bona fide interest in the subject. A commercial exhibition is to be open to all attendees and any information displayed may be viewed freely. Photography of exhibits is to be at the discretion of the exhibitors.

Section 10

Division of Meeting Surplus Revenue: Due to specific organizational variances, the AFSUMB may negotiate an alternate agreement with the host society. Ideally, this activity will take place by the time the contract is awarded. If an alternate agreement is not made with the host society, the division of the meeting surplus revenue may be as follows:

- 70%-Host organization(s) • 30%-The Federation

31. DUTIES OF OFFICERS

c) Treasurer.

2) The funds of the Federation shall be deposited in bank accounts, or investments which guarantee preservation of the principal, including certificates of deposit, mortgage pool certificates and Treasury bills with principal guaranteed.

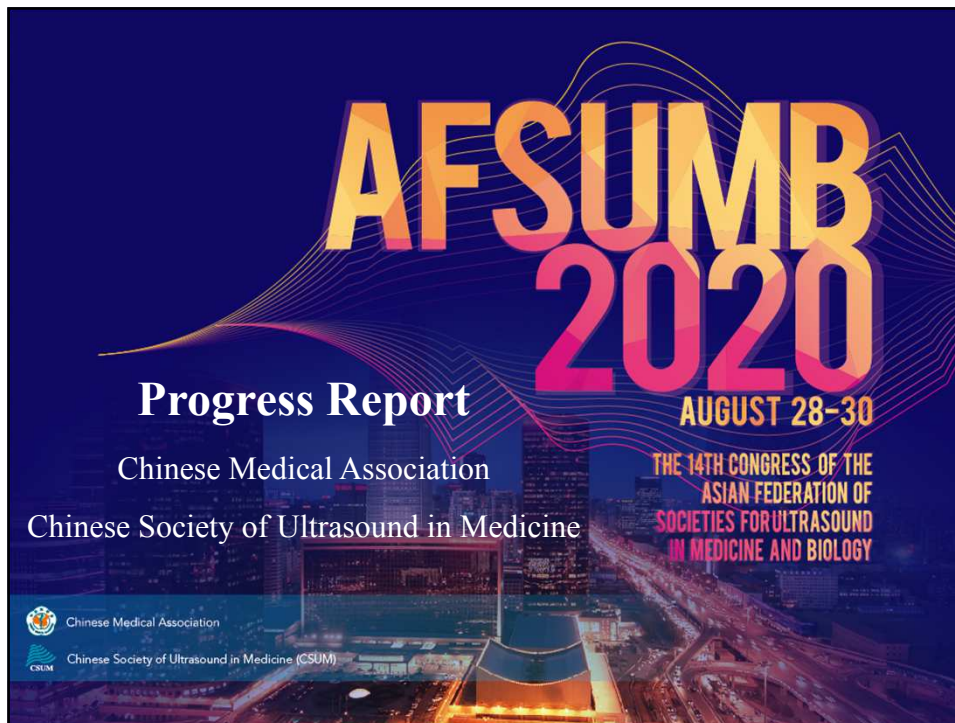
