[1] BSU's National Conference: The 37th National Conference of the Bangladesh Society of Ultrasonography was held on 24 & 25 October 2025; Friday & Saturday, Friday at Radisson Blu Water Garden Hotel Dhaka: Airport Road, Dhaka. Prof. Susan Campbell Westerway, WFUMB Executive, joined the conference as Special Guest. About 250 Delegates joined the conference and workshop. Prof. M. A. Karim, Former Chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission was the Chief Guest.



[2] Post Conference Workshop: Prof. Susan from WFUMB was present at the Conference. On 25 October 2025, the Conference was followed by the most demanding "Full-day Workshop" at INMAS-Dhaka, Dhaka Medical College Campus. 1 International and 5 National Resource Personnel delivered lectures and demonstrate patients.



[3] WFUMB Center of Education Workshops: The 31st WFUMB Center of Education Workshop was held on 14 & 15 February 2025. The title of the workshop was "PERINATAL ULTRASONOGRAPHY". WFUMB Faculty were Prof. Musarrat Hasan-Pakistan, Prof. Mukhtar Ansari-Nepal and Prof. Kanu Bala-Bangladesh, there were 5 BSU Faculties. Resource personnel covered some important areas of Diagnostic Ultrasound. A number of 'Patient and Probe' Sessions were operated by the Foreign Faculty and a Competent Local Faculty. About 250 participants from home and abroad joined the workshops.



[4] WFUMB Congress: WFUMB Congress was held in Kyoto, Japan on May-June 2025. BSU Members joined the World Congress. Few of them presented papers. It was and wonderful even. Delegates from all over the world joined the programs and benefited.



[5] Interventional Ultrasound Course: A course on Interventional Ultrasound was arranged by BSU. It was so popular that we had to repeat the course once more. 60 participants joined the program. It was lecture and hands on program.

[6] Monthly CPD Program: BSU is going on conducting 'Monthly Education Program' on First Friday of Every Month. Average 50- 70 participants join and benefited by the program.

[7] Collaboration Courses: BSU organizes short courses for the beginners and for the specialists. In collaboration with Obstetrical Gynecological Society of Bangladesh, BSU has conducted 3 days course for Practicing Obstetricians and Gynecologists. Another course will be held soon.

[8] Bangladesh Journal of Ultrasonography: BSU publishes two issues of its official journal. The journal is recognized by the Government, Universities, Research Council, etc.

[9] Scholarships: One BSU member is offered 6 months scholarship by the Japan Society of Ultrasonics. In the past time Korean Society and Taiwan Society offered scholarships for our member. We are requesting the concerned societies for continuing with their scholarship programs.

Chinese Taipei Society of Ultrasound in Medicine (CTSUM)

2024 Annual Report of CTSUM

In 2024, we conducted a total of 28 domestic educational courses, including nine Basic Courses, four Advanced Courses, and 12 Workshops (among which one was a *Pre-hospital Ultrasound Workshop* exclusively for EMPT). In addition, four Online Courses were organized, along with three Regional Meetings in conjunction with the election of member representatives.

The major highlight of the year 2024 was the 40th Anniversary & 2024 Annual Convention for the Taiwan Society of Ultrasound in Medicine, held in conjunction with the 6th Asia Pacific International Symposium on Advances in Medical Ultrasound. It took place at the Taipei International Convention Center from October 19 to 20, 2024.

The 6th Asia Pacific International Symposium on Advances in Medical Ultrasound was closed with a hybrid format on October 19th. Almost 140 participants joined the meeting including more than 59 attendants online. They were from Albania, Argentina, Australia, Austria, China, HK, India, Indonesia, Iraq, Japan, Malaysia, Mongolia, Peru, Philippines, Korea, Saudi Arabia, Singapore and Vietnam.

The 40 Anniversary and 2024 Annual Convention of TSUM were more than 2900 attendees. To commemorate this occasion, a special publication book entitled “台灣超音波紀事-40 風華超波新視界” (Taiwan Ultrasound Chronicles – 40 Years of Excellence and a New Vision in Ultrasound) was compiled the journey and development of CTSUM and the advancement of ultrasound technology in Taiwan.

Three Regional Meetings took place at Taichung on May 26, at Taipei on June 30 and at Kaohsiung on July 28, 2024. The scientific programs included Cardiology, Emergency, Gastroenterology, General Medical ultrasound, Musculoskeletal Ultrasound and Ob/Gyn Ultrasound. More than 1,200 participants attended those three regional meetings and a total of 315 member representatives were elected.

The Workshop of Emergency & Critical Care Ultrasound held on July 31, 2024. Thirty-two participants were divided into 4 groups, rotating hands-on stations between topics of Subxiphoid view & IVC, Parasternal & apical view, Chest and abdominal ultrasound.

Pre-hospital Trauma Ultrasound Certification Course for EMPT held on March 25, 2024. Thirty-five participants were divided into 4 groups for hands-on sessions. Each attendee was required to rotate as a model.

Anatomy Ultrasound Workshop took place on May 26, 2024. 27 attendees were rotated hand-on training courses through four subjects as 1. Hepatobiliary tracts, 2. Pancreas, Spleen and Kidney, 3. Esophagus, Stomach, Small and Large Intestine, and 4. Gynecology.

The 12th Musculoskeletal Ultrasound Workshop in Taiwan 2024 was held on May 18–19. The workshop was organized by Dr. Kevin Chang and featured Dr. Levent Özçakar (Department of Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine, Hacettepe University Medical School, Ankara, Turkey) as the special invited lecturer. A total of 95 participants attended the workshop and they were divided into 12 groups for hands-on practice. Among them, 15 were international physicians from Australia, Hong Kong, Indonesia, the Philippines, and Thailand.

The 9th Neuromuscular Ultrasound Workshop in Taiwan 2024 was held on December 14–15. The workshop was organized by Dr. Kevin Chang and featured Dr. Stefan Meng (Medical University of Vienna and Radiology, Hanusch Hospital, Vienna, Austria) as the special invited lecturer. A total of 95 participants attended the workshop and they were divided into 12 groups for hands-on practice. Among them, 17 were international physicians from Croatia, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Mongolia, the Philippines, Singapore, and Thailand.

2025 Annual Report of CTSUM

In 2025, we organized a total of 27 domestic educational courses, including nine Basic Courses, four Advanced Courses, and five Workshops, one of which was a Pre-hospital Ultrasound Workshop exclusively for EMPT. Seven Online Courses and two POCUS Certificate Courses were conducted during this year.

The 7th Asia Pacific International Symposium on Advances in Medical Ultrasound (APISAMU) was held in Taipei on October 18, 2025, in conjunction with the 41st Anniversary and 2025 Annual Convention of the Taiwan Society of Ultrasound in Medicine (TSUM) on October 18–19. The event, themed “Recent Advances in Ultrasonography of Liver Diseases,” featured distinguished speakers from six countries, including representatives from AFSUMB and WFUMB, and was conducted in a hybrid format.

The 13th Musculoskeletal Ultrasound Workshop in Taiwan 2025 was held on May 10–11. The workshop was organized by Dr. Kevin Chang and featured Dr. Levent Özçakar (Department of Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine, Hacettepe University Medical School, Ankara, Turkey) as the special invited lecturer. A total of 96 participants attended the workshop and they were divided into 12 groups for hands-on practice sessions. Among

them, 23 were international physicians from Croatia, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Italy, Malaysia, the Philippines, and Thailand.

The 10th Neuromuscular Ultrasound Workshop in Taiwan 2025 was held on December 20-21. The workshop was organized by Dr. Kevin Chang and featured Dr. Kamal Mezian (First Faculty of Medicine and General University Hospital in Prague, Czech Republic) as the special invited lecturer. A total of 96 participants attended the workshop and were divided into 12 groups for hands-on practice sessions. Among the attendees, 20 were international physicians from Australia, Hong Kong, Indonesia, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Turkey, and the USA.

The Ultrasound in Long-term Care Medicine course was conducted on separate four days—July 13, 20, 27, and August 3 - in collaboration with the Chinese Medical Doctor Association. The course covered a comprehensive range of ultrasound diagnostic applications and a training course for Chinese Medicine doctors to use ultrasound machine as a preliminary diagnostic tool. A total of 96 participants attended the workshop and they were divided into 8 groups for hands-on practice sessions.

The preliminary POCUS course and certification test were held on November 16 and December 25, 2025. A total of 120 members attended the courses, including 60 who took part in the hands-on certification test.

Annual report of Hong Kong Society for Ultrasound in Medicine 2024-May 2025 for submission to AFSUMB

1. HKSUM co-organized with The Federation of Medical Societies of Hong Kong to hold a certificate course on medical ultrasound. The course consisted of six web lectures from 7:00 to 8:30 pm between 22 May to 26 June 2024. The details are listed in the attached poster (Appendix 1). The course was successfully completed, and there were 88 attendants.

2. HKSUM successfully held the Annual General Meeting (AGM) and annual scientific meeting in Cordis Hotel at 2:00-4:15 pm on 3 August 2024. The details are listed in the attached poster (Appendix 2).

3. Radiographer Board invited HKSUM to renew our status as Accredited Program Provider for CPD scheme for registered radiographers.

4. Obstetrical and Gynaecological Society of Hong Kong (OGSHK) HKSUM was one of the supporting organisation of the OGSHK Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM) on 5-6 October 2024. There was a HKSUM session on 6 October morning (Appendix 3). The ASM was successfully held, and HKSUM shared a profit.

5. After a regular review in 2025, Inland Revenue Department confirmed the charitable status of our Society (HKSUM).

6. HKSUM co-organized with The Federation of Medical Societies of Hong Kong to hold a certificate course on medical ultrasound: a practical approach in May-July 2025 (Appendix 4).

7. Being invited by the Federation of Medical Societies of Hong Kong, Dr. KY Leung, on behalf of HKSUM sent a supporting letter to Tobacco Control Legislation (Amendment) Bill 2025 Bills Committee to support 'Prompt Passage of the Tobacco Control Legislation (Amendment) Bill 2025'.

8. Dr. KY Leung, as the President of our Society, continued to be one of the Hong Kong Convention Ambassadors.

9. Ultrasound course organized by the Macau Association of Obstetrics and Gynaecology

Our Society was invited to support this program. The first part (on gynaecology and early pregnancy ultrasound) was held in April



2024, and the second part (on mid and late pregnancy ultrasound) was held in Macau in August and September 2024.

10. Asian Federation of Societies of Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology (AFSUMB).

- Dr. KY Leung, as a chairman of the education committee of AFSUM, gave talks in the AFSUMB workshop in Dhaka on 1-2 March 2024 (Appendix 5).
- AFSUMB and WFUMB (World Federation for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology) organized a student webinar program in Asia. There were ten web lectures (Appendix 6). Registration was free to the undergraduate students. Dr. KY Leung was a co-ordinator of this program, and presented one talk on 'Ultrasonography of normal pregnancy' on 20 January 2024.
- Dr. KY Leung together with other presidents/ representatives of the ASFUMB affiliated societies coauthored a manuscript titled 'The Utility and challenges of ultrasound education to medical and allied health students in Asia' which has been published in the Hong Kong Medical Journal 2024 Feb;30(1):75-79 (Appendix 7) .
- Dr. KY Leung attended the AFSUMB administrative Council meeting on 9 May 2024. After the meeting, he stepped down from the chairman of education committee of AFSUMB after serving the post for six years, and continued serving as a co-opt council member of AFSUMB.

ANNUAL REPORT OF IFUMB

IFUMB has been engaged in various academic activities from its beginning to enhance the knowledge of our members. This year also we had national and local level academic activities under leadership of our respected president Prof. Dr. Mrs. Shabnam Bhandari Grover.

The Year began with 32nd annual conference 'USCON 2024' which was held Mumbai between 20 and 22nd September 2024 at Hotel Grand Hyatt. It was a very successful conference and was attended by around 400 delegates. Conference held in collaboration with SRU, USA. Three renowned International speakers Pro. Ann Kennedy, David Fetzer and Margrat Revzin delivered their talks. Around 60 national speakers shared their knowledge through various live demos and didactic lectures. More than 25 live demos were conducted during the conference.

Another major hallmark of our academic activities is ICMU outreach CMEs which were held under leadership of Dr. Manjula Virmani. These CMEs have become a hallmark of our excellent academic activities. Last year we have organised 6 outreach CMEs in Gurugram, Sikkim, Patna, Palakol, and Jaipur. Various topics were covered extensively in these CMEs. Dr. Ramamurti, Dr. TLN Praveen, Dr. Ashok Khurana, Dr. Gokhale, Dr. M. Virmani, Dr. Ladbans Kaur, Dr. Tailor, Dr. Ashwin Lawande and many other eminent faculties shared their knowledge and work in these CMEs.

Another very successful activity of ICMU is Monthly Webinars which were kept almost every month and number of participants are increasing with each Webinar. More than 12 webinars were organised during last year which included many National and International faculties. These webinars covered varied subjects like TIRAD, Renal Cysts from womb to tomb, Doppler waveforms, Obstetrics Emergencies, Pelvic floor imaging, Liver elastography, Gall bladder imaging, IDEA protocol etc.

I am very happy to inform that IFUMB has won the bid to host the WFUMB Congress in 2029. The bid was contested at WFUMB Congress at Kyoto, Japan in this year. There we had a tough competition from Australia.

IFUMB chapters are also very active in their respective states. Various IFUMB chapters are doing many clinical activities in various parts of country like Indore, Patna, Delhi, Jaipur and Mumbai.

IFUMB websites is active and we are offering online membership. Various VDO lectures are also uploaded in 'members only' region of website. Also we are putting details of forthcoming Webinar in this website along with link to join it.

The 33 rd Annual Conference of IFUMB ' USCON 2025' was held along with the AFSUMB workshop on 3 rd to 5 th Oct. 2025. It was held in the beautiful and historical city of Jaipur in India, at the Jaipur Marriot Hotel.

The conference and the workshop were very successful. The number of delegates who attended the event reached more than 400 participants. The delegates came from different parts of India. Renowned 8 International and 70 National Faculties shared their knowledge through various lectures and live demos. The scientific content and the discussions were of a very high standard. AFSUMB workshop was a big hit and was very well attended by the participants. Eminent AFSUMB faculties Dr. Quan Bao Nguyen- Phouc from Vietnam, Dr. Kanu Bala from Bangladesh and Dr. T.P. Baskaran from Malaysia delivered their talks. The scientific sessions included over 60 hours of lectures and over 15 live demo workshops. Trade participation was also remarkable with display of state of artequipment in the stalls and in live demos.

1. The 97th Annual Scientific Meeting of the Japan Society of Ultrasonics in Medicine

Venue: Pacifico Yokohama, Yokohama, Kanagawa, Japan. **Dates:**

May 31 to June 2, 2024

The 97th Annual Scientific Meeting of the Japan Society of Ultrasonics in Medicine (President: Shiro Iwanaga) was held at Pacifico Yokohama from May 31 to June 2, 2024. A total of 7424 doctors and sonographers participate in the Meeting.

2. The 98th Annual Scientific Meeting of the Japan Society of Ultrasonics in Medicine with the 20th World Federation for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology Congress

Venue: Kyoto International Conference Center, Kyoto, Japan.

Dates: May 30 to June 1, 2025

Number of participants: 9227

The 98th Annual Scientific Meeting of the Japan Society of Ultrasonics in Medicine (President: Masayuki Kitano) was held at the Kyoto International Conference Center from May 30 to June 1, 2025. This meeting was jointly organized with the 20th World Federation for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology Congress (WFUMB 2025) (President: Iwaki Akiyama) and the 2nd Spring Meeting of the Japan Association of Breast and Thyroid Sonology (President: Kazuki Nakajima). Although the 98th Annual Scientific Meeting was held over the three days mentioned above, WFUMB 2025 began one day earlier, on Thursday, May 29, making the total duration of the event four days.

A large number of participants attended from both Japan and abroad, including attendees from 70 countries (Table 1). Including web-based participation, more than 9,000 participants from Japan and abroad (Table 1) attended, and over 2,600 presentations

were delivered, making the meeting a great success.

WFUMB 2025 also featured joint sessions with international organizations such as IFMSA (International Federation of Medical Students' Associations), WFPI (World Federation of Pediatric Imaging), SRU (Society of Radiologists in Ultrasound), ACUCI (Asian Conference on Ultrasound Contrast Imaging), ICUS (International Contrast Ultrasound Society), and ISUOG (International Society of Ultrasound in Obstetrics and Gynecology).

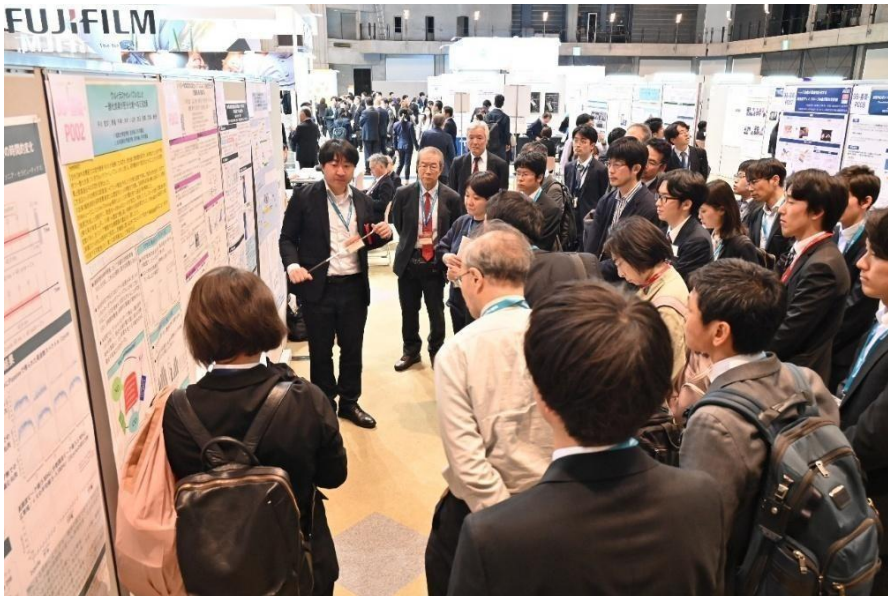


Figure 3. Poster session venue. Many participants gathered in the poster hall, where lively discussions took place.

At the public lecture held on the final day, under the theme “How Are Diseases Detected? — The Role of Ultrasound Examinations —,” experts from each field delivered lectures on the role of ultrasound in gastroenterology, cardiology, obstetrics and gynecology, and nephrology/urology (Figure 5).

As a result of active outreach, mainly to residents of Kyoto Prefecture, 160 members of the public attended. The lecture provided an opportunity for participants to gain an understanding of how widely ultrasound examinations are used in medical practice. Its appeal lay in the opportunity to learn about a variety of diseases, which likely contributed to the strong public participation.

Korean Society of Ultrasound in Medicine (KSUM)

The Korean society of ultrasound in medicine (KSUM) passionately hosted and supported various domestic and international research and academic activities related to medical ultrasound throughout 2025.

1. AFSUMB 2024: Scientific Excellence and Global Collaboration in Ultrasound

The 16th Congress of the Asian Federation of Societies for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology (AFSUMB 2024), held in conjunction with the 56th Annual Congress of the Korean Society of Ultrasound in Medicine (KSUM 2024), took place in Seoul, Korea, from May 9 to 11, 2024.

A total of 1,657 participants attended the congress, including 485 international delegates from 41 countries. The participation of 238 invited speakers from 22 countries reflected the international scope and scientific standing of the meeting.

Under the theme “Shaping the Future with Ultrasound,” the congress presented a comprehensive scientific program comprising 151 invited lectures and 355 electronic poster presentations. The program covered a broad range of topics in diagnostic and interventional ultrasound, addressing recent advances and emerging trends in the field.

The scientific program included the Jisan Lecture, 10 categorical courses (34 lectures), 4 Hot Issue sessions (13 lectures), and 8 Special Focus sessions (25 lectures), providing structured coverage of key clinical and research areas. The Meet the Professor sessions enabled direct academic exchange with experts. In addition, the program featured 2 joint symposiums with affiliated societies, 6 satellite symposiums in collaboration with KISTIA, and 5 luncheon symposiums (9 lectures).

The congress also included 11 scientific sessions with 91 oral presentations and a Young Investigator Award session comprising 8 presentations, supporting the dissemination of current research and the development of early-career investigators. A total of 36 case-based presentations were delivered, and the Best Session, conducted in an open discussion format, facilitated active academic interaction.

Interactive components included the Interactive Case Review session, attended by approximately 200 participants, and two hands-on sessions, both of which provided opportunities for case-based discussion and practical training.

A total of 21 companies participated in the exhibition, contributing to academic–industry exchange.

AFSUMB 2024 demonstrated a high level of scientific rigor and international collaboration, providing a platform for knowledge exchange and the advancement of ultrasound practice and research.

2. Regular ultrasound education and training course and hands-on workshop

We also conducted a regular ultrasound education and training course on November 9 in Seoul, under the theme “Start Again with Ultrasound: From Basics to Practice.”

In addition, six hands-on workshops covering the breast, thyroid, abdomen, and genitourinary systems were held under the auspices of the KSUM Academy for Education

(KAFE).

More than 100 participants, including many radiologists and clinicians from various specialties, attended the program. They had a valuable opportunity to acquire practical skills and knowledge in performing medical ultrasound.

3. International fellowship

We implemented an international fellowship program in order to enhance medical ultrasound-related research and clinical practice by training applicants in Korean academic institutions. A total of two fellows were selected in 2024 (one from Chinese Taipei and one from India), and one fellow was selected in 2025 (from Chinese Taipei).

4. « Ultrasonography » _ the official journal of KSUM

We publish « Ultrasonography » which is the official English-language journal of the KSUM and an international peer-reviewed academic journal dedicated to practice, research, technology, and education in medical ultrasound. The journal currently publishes six issues per year. *Ultrasonography* aims to provide updated information on new diagnostic or therapeutic concepts and technical developments, including experimental animal studies using new equipment in addition to well-designed reviews of contemporary issues in patient care. This journal was recorded as having an impact factor of 2.5 in JCR 2024 edition.

5. KSUM 2025

The 56th Annual Congress of the Korean Society of Ultrasound in Medicine (KSUM 2025) was held at COEX, Seoul, Korea, from May 8 to 9, 2025.

A total of 1,054 participants from 23 countries attended the congress, reflecting continued international engagement. The scientific program comprised 197 presentations, including 90 invited lectures, 55 oral presentations, and 63 electronic posters, covering a broad range of topics in diagnostic and interventional ultrasound.

The program included key components such as the Jisan Lecture, Categorical Courses, Special Focus Sessions, and Hot Issue sessions, providing structured coverage of major clinical and research areas. In addition, Interactive Case Review sessions, Live Demonstrations, and Hands-on Sessions offered opportunities for case-based discussion and practical learning.

Additional sessions, including the Young Investigator Award session and Ultrasound, the Best (informal scientific session), facilitated academic exchange and supported the presentation of emerging research and clinical experience.

KSUM 2025 served as a platform for the dissemination of current knowledge and the exchange of clinical experience, contributing to the advancement of ultrasound practice and research. The congress also provided opportunities for continued collaboration within the global ultrasound community.

6. KSUM 2026

The Korean Society of Ultrasound in Medicine (KSUM) will host the 57th Annual Congress (KSUM 2026) at COEX, Seoul, Korea, from May 7 to 8, 2026.

The congress is being designed as a two-day scientific program to provide participants with opportunities to learn about the latest research developments and engage with leading experts in the field of ultrasound in medicine and biology. Renowned international and Asian scholars will be invited to deliver state-of-the-art lectures and share their insights.

In addition, the organizing committee is preparing various awards and recognition programs to encourage academic excellence and acknowledge outstanding contributions.

KSUM 2026 is expected to offer a valuable platform for knowledge exchange and professional networking, further strengthening its role as a leading academic congress in the field.

Yearly report (2024-2025) of the Chinese Medical Association/Chinese Society of Ultrasound in Medicine (CMA/CSUM)

In 2024, CMA/CSUM convened two flagship conferences, conducted extensive continuing education programs and workshops, and promoted interdisciplinary exchange and career development. These efforts advanced the Society's role in scientific innovation, clinical competency, and professional collaboration. In 2025, the Society will continue to organize its annual congress and youth forum to support the discipline's growth, as outlined below.

1. Meetings in 2024

1) The 24th Annual Academic Conference of Ultrasound Medicine, CMA/CSUM

The 24th Annual Academic Conference of Ultrasound Medicine, CMA/CSUM, was held from November 14 to 17, 2024, in Wuhan, China. The conference featured one plenary session and nine thematic sessions, including special sessions on artificial intelligence and biomedical engineering integration, as well as medical humanities and science popularization. A total of 6 plenary lectures, 193 thematic presentations, 51 continuing education lectures, 790 oral presentations, and 31 case reports were delivered. With 6,883 abstracts submitted and nearly 3,000 attendees, the conference served as a major platform for academic exchange and interdisciplinary collaboration in ultrasound medicine.

2) The 2nd Youth Academic Conference on Ultrasound Medicine, CMA/CSUM

The 2nd Youth Academic Conference on Ultrasound Medicine, CMA/CSUM, took place from March 21 to 24, 2024, in Xi'an, China. The conference comprised one plenary session and eleven parallel sessions, featuring roundtable discussions, industry-academia workshops, hands-on demonstrations, and English morning presentations. The program included 5 plenary lectures, 25 thematic presentations, 139 oral presentations, 10 case reports, and 37 science popularization presentations and displays. The conference received 2,854 submissions and attracted over 1,000 participants, reflecting the Society's commitment to fostering young physicians and promoting innovation and scientific communication.

2. 2024 Continuing Education, Training, and Workshops

1) Pre-conference continuing education courses were held annually before the national congress, covering both fundamental and advanced topics in abdominal, cardiovascular, obstetric and gynecologic, superficial organ, vascular, and interventional ultrasound.

2) Specialized committees organized approximately 180 continuing education programs, seminars, lectures, and workshops throughout the year, including training workshops on emerging ultrasound technologies, artificial intelligence, nanotechnology, and clinical statistics. Two sessions of the research training workshops were conducted, attracting over 160,000 participants through both on-site

and online modalities.

- COE Educational Programs (March 6, 2025): Two specific courses were held in Hue just before the national congress:

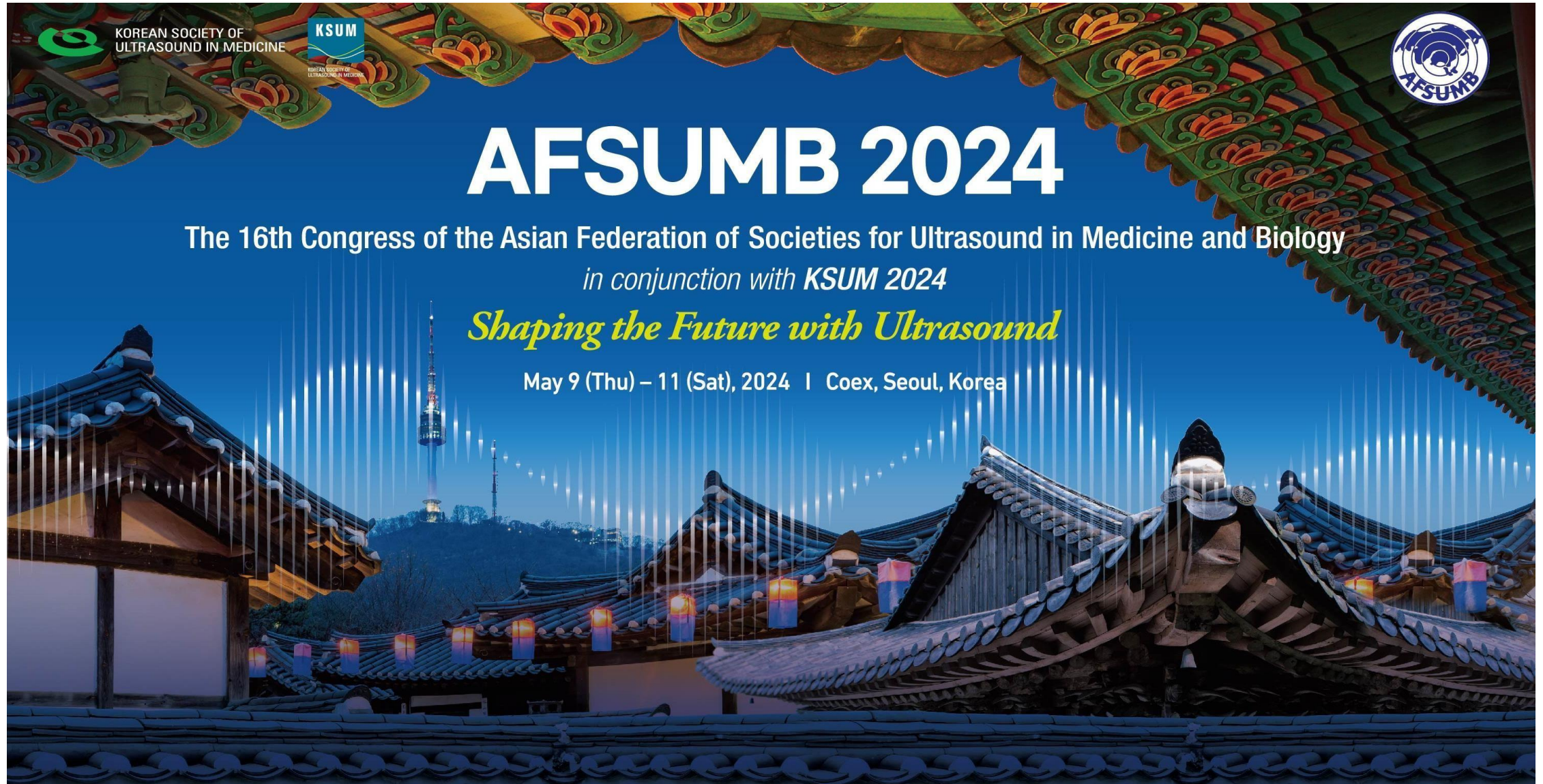
- o Emergency Ultrasound: Attended by 144 participants.
